## AGENCY DESCRIPTOR TABLE D11 – EXPENDITURE DETAIL

### D11 – EXPENDITURE DETAIL

The D11 table identifies the code and title for each Expenditure Detail as defined by your agency within an expenditure subobject. The table contains your agency number, the related expenditure subobject, and your agency detail. Every agency can have the same detail with different titles since this table entry key identifies each individual agency. Be sure that the detail is relevant to the expenditure subobject since it will roll into that subobject for reporting.

### D11 – EXPENDITURE DETAIL DATA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<u>Data Element</u>	<u>Description</u>
TABLE-ID-NUMBER	Enter 11.
TABLE-ENTRY-KEY	AGCY - Enter the three-digit agency code set up in Descriptor Table 02 for your agency.  SUB-OBJ - Enter the four-digit expenditure subobject set up in Descriptor Table 10 for the subobject this detail supports. This detail will have all of the controls and reporting elements of this subobject.

<b>Data Element</b>	<b>Description</b>
	DETAIL - Enter the two-digit expenditure subobject detail that your agency assigns. Use detail to breakdown subobject information to assist agency management.
REFERENCE DATA	Leave blank.
TITLE	Enter the name, up to 50 characters, your agency assigns for this detail. This will show on your expenditure reports.
EFF-START-DATE EFF-END-DATE	Enter the six-digit start and/or end date to stop transactions with this expenditure subobject detail from processing.
