STATEWIDE DESCRIPTOR TABLE D34 – REVENUE SUBOBJECT

D34 – REVENUE SUBOBJECT

The D34 table identifies the Revenue Object, Summary Object, and Subobject structures, and defines the hierarchical relationship among the tables. This identifies the governmental and proprietary class codes for GAAP reporting, as well as the FAS asset class STARS uses when sending the information to the FAS hold file. This includes the title for each revenue element.

D34 – REVENUE SUBOBJECT DATA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<u>Data Element</u>	<u>Description</u>
TABLE-ID-NUMBER	Enter 34 .
TABLE-ENTRY-KEY	Enter the four-digit Revenue Object, Summary Object, or Subobject.

Data Element	Description
REFERENCE DATA	<p><u>OBJ</u> Enter the four-digit Revenue Object. If setting up a new revenue item, enter the following: Revenue Object –the same as the TABLE-ENTRY-KEY. Revenue Summary Object or Subobject- this must be a Revenue Object previously set up in this table. These summary and Subobjects can roll up into this object for reporting purposes.</p> <p><u>SUM OBJ</u> Enter the four-digit Revenue Summary Object. If setting up a new revenue item, enter the following: Revenue Object – leave blank Revenue Summary Object – this would be the same as the table entry key. Revenue Subobject – this must be a Revenue Summary Object previously set up in this table. These Subobjects can roll up into this Summary Object for reporting purposes.</p> <p><u>GVT</u> Enter the three-digit governmental class code set up in Descriptor Table 43. Used for GAAP reporting.</p> <p><u>PROP</u> Enter the three-digit proprietary class code set up in Descriptor Table 44. Used for GAAP reporting.</p> <p><u>ASST CLS</u> Enter the one-digit property asset class for use when STARS creates a transaction code to send to the FAS hold file. FAS asset classes are: Blank – revenue item does not feed to FAS 1 – Land 2 – Building 3 – Improvement other than Buildings 4 – Machinery & Equipment 5 – Construction-in-Progress 6 – Infrastructure</p>

Data Element	Description
EFF-START-DATE EFF-END-DATE	Enter the six-digit start and/or end date to stop transactions with this Revenue Subobject from processing.
TITLE	Enter the name of the Revenue Object, Summary Object, or Subobject, up to 50 characters.
