AGENCY DESCRIPTOR TABLE D35 – REVENUE DETAIL

D35 – REVENUE DETAIL

The D35 table identifies the title for each Revenue Subobject Detail as defined by your agency within a revenue subobject. The table contains your agency number, the related Revenue Subobject, and your agency Detail code. Every agency can have the same Detail with different titles. Be sure that the Detail is relevant to the Revenue Subobject since for reporting.

D35 – REVENUE DETAIL DATA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<u>Data Element</u>	<u>Description</u>
TABLE-ID-NUMBER	Enter 35.
TABLE-ENTRY-KEY	<p>AGENCY - Enter the three-digit agency code set up in Descriptor Table 02 for your agency.</p> <p>REV SUB - Enter the four-digit revenue subobject set up in Descriptor Table 34 for the subobject this detail supports. This detail will have all of the controls and reporting elements of this subobject.</p> <p>DETAIL - Enter the two-digit revenue subobject detail that your agency assigns. Use this to give more detail to subobject information to assist agency management.</p>

Data Element	Description
REFERENCE DATA	Leave blank.
TITLE	Enter the name, up to 50 characters, your agency assigns for this revenue detail. This name will show on your revenue reports.
EFF-START-DATE EFF-END-DATE	Enter the six-digit start and/or end date to stop transactions with this revenue subobject detail from processing.
